ANTIQUÉ AIRCRAFT AIR TOUR

The Pacific Northwest Air Tour is coming to Blackfoot, Idaho on Wednesday, July 14th. Over thirty antique and classic airplanes will be arriving during the early afternoon on Wednesday and will depart Thursday morning by 10:00 AM.

The Puget Sound Antique Airplane Club is organizing the air tour. The objective of the Air Tour is to recreate the historic barnstorming tours of the 1930's that brought aviation appreciation to communities across the nation. A sampling of plane types will include: Pre-war Howards, and Interstates; Stearman and Naval Aircraft Factory military trainers; and numerous post war Aeronca, Beechcraft, Bellanca, Cessna, Piper and Taylorcraft aircraft.

The public is invited to come out and view these remarkable planes during their stay at the Blackfoot airport, McCarley Field.

The tour begins in La Grande, OR and will make stops in Nampa, Emmett, Buhl, Blackfoot and Jerome, ID before finishing in Ontario, OR.
