Amount

\$1,500.00

Eligibility

Must be a US Citizen, Idaho or Oregon Resident,
18-45 Years of Age

Requirements

Attendance or acceptance into an accredited university, college, or trade school where the scholarship will be used for flight training. If applying for private pilot training with a CFI, the applicant must have soloed. This scholarship is for primary flight training only and not for ratings beyond private pilot.

Application Procedure

Submit a one page letter to the IAA with a current resume. The letter should include at least the following: aviation interest and goals, relevant transcript(s) including GPA and written exam score, log book entry showing solo, intended school of attendance or flight instructor, and contact information.

Recommendation letters are encouraged. Applicants will be evaluated and selected by the IAA Scholarship Committee.

Deadline

The completed application and supporting documents may be received by the IAA at any time.

Terms

The one year scholarship will be awarded when approved by the committee and SP Air. The funds will be deposited in the student's institutional account, or paid on a reimbursement basis if working through an independent CFI. Any funds not used within one year of the scholarship award date must be repaid to the IAA Scholarship Fund.
