Eligibility

US citizen, Idaho resident at least 16 but not older than 25

Amount

\$3,000.00

Requirements

Attendance or acceptance into an accredited university, college or trade school where the scholarship will be used for flight training; if applying for a scholarship for private pilot flight training with a CFI, the applicant must have passed the private written exam and soloed. If applying for instrument training, multi-engine, commercial, CFI, CFII, or ATP then a private pilot license is required and the written test that applies to the desired rating must be completed and passed within 90 days prior to application submission.

Application procedure

Submit a one page letter to the IAA with a current resume. The letter should include at least the following: aviation interest and goals, relevant transcript(s) including GPA, intended school of attendance or flight instructor, and contact information. Recommendation letters are encouraged. Applicants will be evaluated at the sole discretion of the IAA Scholarship Committee.

Deadline

The completed application and supporting documents can be received by the IAA at any time.

Terms

The one year scholarship will be awarded when approved by the committee and the funds will be deposited in the student's institutional account, or paid on a reimbursement basis if working through an independent CFI. Any funds not used within one year of scholarship award date will revert to the IAA scholarship fund.
